**CIT Training Included!**

Club Noar is designed for YOU. 7th, 8th, and 9th grade "people" are NOT little kids anymore (and we don't mean that mockingly). They are old enough to see through the charm of day camp, but still NOT old enough to drive.

Club Noar provides a chance for teens to experience a new world of opportunity while learning new skills

They Can:

- Be counselors in training, and earn community service hours while assisting the Camp Menorah Counselors.
- Travel with Camp Menorah wherever they go, helping at the park, field trips, or creating programs.
- Attend classes and seminars on leadership training and the "how to's" of working with kids of all ages.

There is also a part of Club Noar, that lets teens be teens. We help these teens and give them the tools to do what interests them. Two Nights a week Club Noar meets separately from the rest of Camp, and when they do, the possibilities are ENDLESS. The staff has a wide variety of skills and talents and every participant has the freedom to choose to learn or try any number of these. Guitar, singing, drawing, cooking, whatever they want to learn, We want to help facilitate their choices and learning. B'nai Mitzvah preparation will be here those nights too for students training for their special days.

Last, but not least is the COMPLETELY teen produced segment, the Thursday Field Trip. At the beginning of the week there will be computer lab time to research and agree upon a field trip for Thursday evening. With use of the Van, and a license to operate, we can go almost anywhere that they choose. The possibilities are incredible, and teens learn the value of money and organization through:

- calculating the gas costs
- entrance fees
- time in transportation
- And much more

The skills needed to plan are NOT as simple as one might think. The programming skills and experiences gained through Club Noar will remain with your teen forever!

# Pricing

The Club Noar program is divided into weeks, and teens can choose 3 to 5 sessions per week to attend. Prices are explained on the registration form. If you are attending one of the field trips with Camp Menorah on a Wednesday, the price of the field trip will be added to your bill. Because of the "teen produced" aspect of our programming, your full bill is NOT available when you first register. As each Thursday activity is planned the teens compute all the costs, and we bill you accordingly.
