The word "Chavurah" (plural: Chavurot) means fellowship or friendship. Each Chavurah is a small community of congregants who meet in each other's homes to socialize, celebrate and/or study Jewish life together. The Chavurah draws its members together and becomes an extended family, enabling personal relationships to develop. Participants experience the warmth and good feelings that come from a sense of belonging. Each Chavurah sets its own course. They meet on a regular basis, at a time chosen by each group.
