All you have to do is decide who you would like to send a Mishloach Manot greetings or good wishes to by checking the box next to their name, complete the order form (including your payment), and send it back to Temple Menorah by March 1st, and we'll take care of the rest.

Then on Sunday, March 20, 2011, at our annual Purim Carnival, everyone can pick up their hand packed (by Temple Menorah Volunteers) Mishloach Manot bag.
